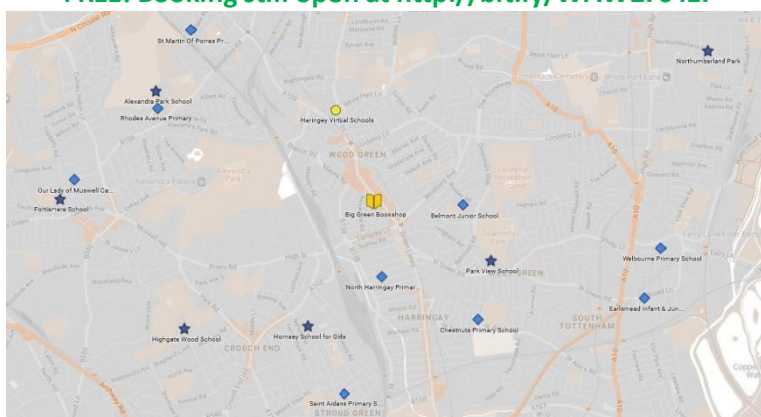

Authors, storytellers and schools: the opportunities in Haringey. A presentation by **Patrice Lawrence** (Author of *Orangeboy*: Winner of the Waterstones Children's Book Prize for Older Children 2016 and shortlisted for the Costa Book Award 2016); Programme Manager at Spread the Word; Patron of Reading at Northumberland Park School).

Success in creative writing: how do we help children on their journey? Presentations from **Haringey teachers** on approaches to creative writing in primary and secondary phases (with a focus on the demands of **creative writing in the new GCSE**, and on **writing at the transition**).
